Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to you following the most recent government guidelines regarding school closures. The government has asked parents/carers to keep their children at home, wherever possible, and asked schools to remain open only for those children who absolutely need to attend.

Schools are, therefore, being asked to continue to provide care for a limited number of children – “children who are vulnerable and children whose parents/carers are critical to the Covid-19 response and cannot be safely cared for at home.”

We are able to offer supervised study between the hours of 9.00am and 3.00pm in a small area of school, with library and IT facilities.
