Hazelwick School GCSE Results Summer 2020

Hazelwick students again produced outstanding GCSE results with our Year 11's achieving outcomes in line with our recent outstanding progress. Our students achieved an excellent Progress 8 outcome, +0.74, maintaining Hazelwick's place as one of the top state schools, for GCSE outcomes, in the county.

In addition to the superb progress shown by our students, nearly one quarter achieved the English Baccalaureate, based on the new tougher 9-5 measure across all the Baccalaureate subjects, compared to a figure of 19.5% achieved nationally in 2018 using the standard 9-4 measure. Combined with an impressive 29% of grades at 9-7 (A*-A) level, including eighty students who achieved in excess of five grades at this level, we are very proud of our students' superb achievements, which is a fitting reward for the hard work and commitment shown.

Fifty six students achieved seven or more 9-7 (A*-A), including an amazing ten perfect grades (grade 9) by two students; Amy Hill and Hafsa Zamir.
