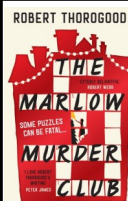


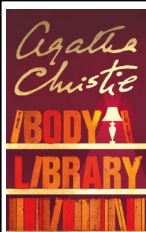
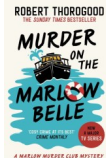
Adult Detective Fiction

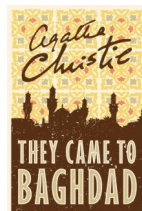
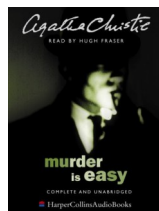
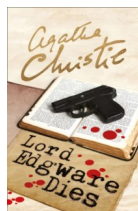
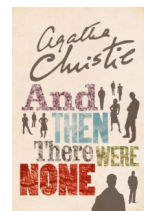
The Body in the Library by Agatha Christie

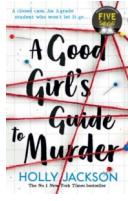

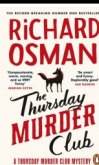

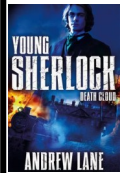
Here, you will find a selection of detective fiction, for younger and older readers.

Enola Holmes series By Nancy Springer

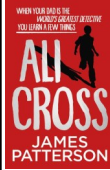

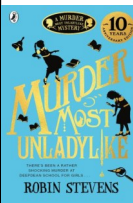


The Ali Cross series by James Patterson

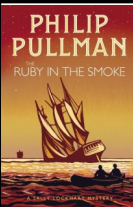


Murder Most Unladylike series by Robin Stevens

Ruby in the Smoke (Sally Lockhart series) by Philip Pullman

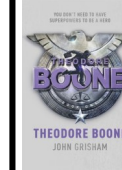

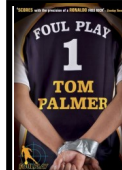


The Highland Falcon Thief (Adventures on Trains series) by M.G. Leonard & Sam Sedgman
