

The Dos and Donuts of Love by Adiba Jaigirdar

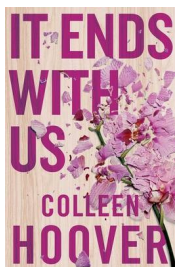

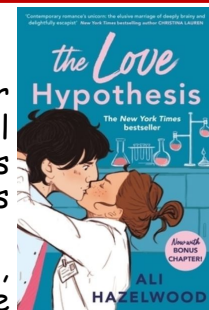

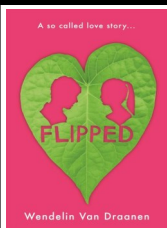


The Sun is Also a Star by Nicola Yoon

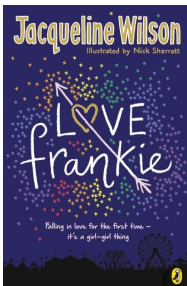
