Frodo begins his perilous journey across Middle-Earth to the Dark Lord's territory, where he must destroy the Ring forever and stop the Dark Lord's plans.

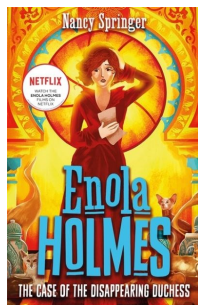

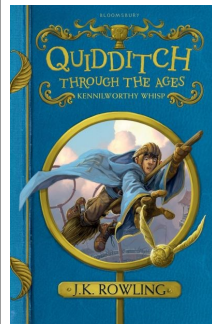

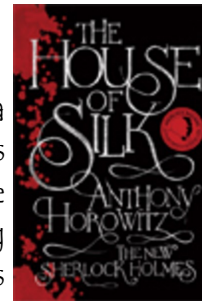

The House of Silk

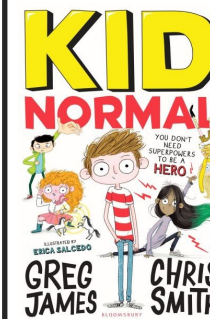

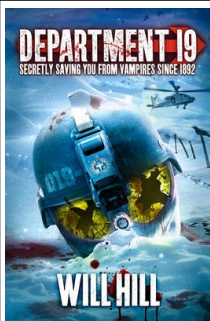
Kid Normal

by Will Hill

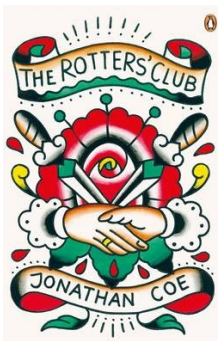

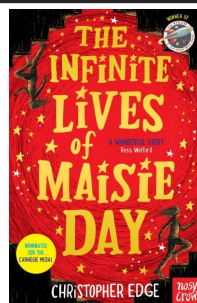
Jane Eyre

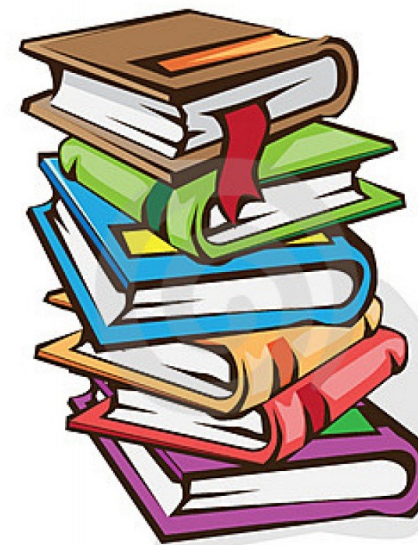
The Infinite Lives of Maisie Day
