Everyone has something to hide, especially high school juniors Spencer, Aria, Emily and Hanna.

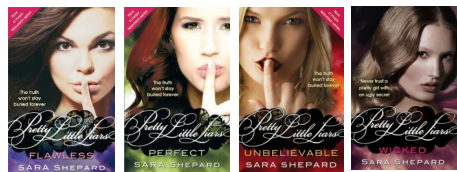

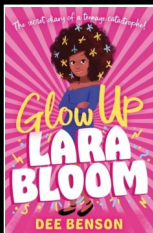
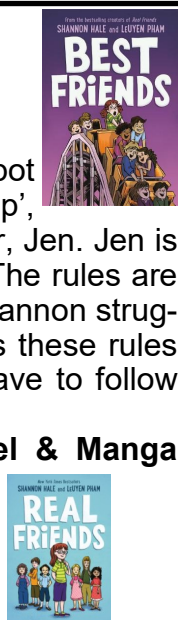
Best Friends by Shannon Hale

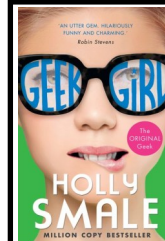
The Extremely Embarrassing Life of Lottie Brooks by Katie Kirby

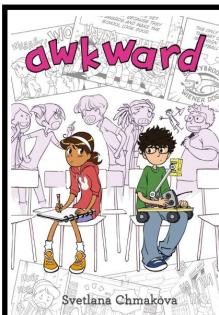
As more letters arrive for more people on the periphery of Freya's life, Sophie and Win begin to piece together who Freya was and why she left.

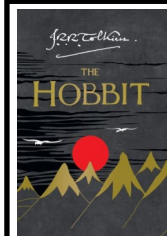
Awkward

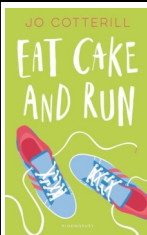


The Hobbit
