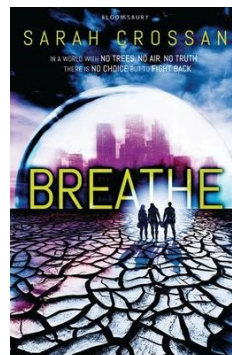
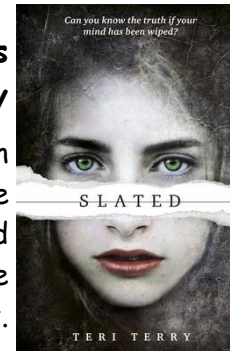


The Lunar Chronicles by Marissa Meyer

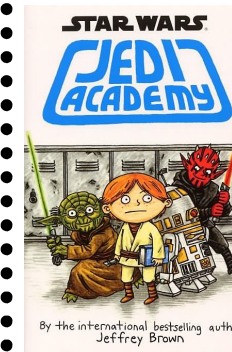
Dystopian series in which a girl whose memory was wiped struggles to find out the truth about her past.

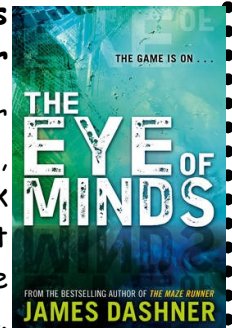


Jedi Academy series by Jeffrey Brown
