

Sixth Form Course Entry Requirements 2022

All of our level 3 courses require students to have a minimum of 5 x grade 4 GCSE/Level 2 Pass. Each subject then has its own additional requirements.

A level Subject	GCSE Entry requirements
Art, Craft & Design	5 in Art and Design
Biology	6 in Triple Science Biology or 6-6 in Combined Science and 5 in Maths.
Business	Either 6 in Business (if taken at GCSE) or Grade 6 in English Language/English Literature. In both cases a Grade 5 in Maths is expected. Please note that you cannot opt for both Business and Economics.
Chemistry	6 in Triple Science Chemistry or 6-6 in Combined Science and 5 in Maths.
Computer Science	Grade 6 in Maths. (GCSE Computer Science is not essential but, if taken, then a grade 6 is required) Please note that you cannot opt for both Computer Science and IT.
Drama & Theatre	Grade 6 in English Language or English Literature and 6 in GCSE Drama, if taken.
Economics	6 in Business Studies (if taken at GCSE) or Grade 6 in English Language/English Literature, in both cases a Grade 6 in Maths is required. Please note that you cannot opt for both Economics and Business.
Electronics	6 in Triple Science Physics or 6-5 in Combined Science and 5 in Maths.
English Language	6 in English Language and 6 in English Literature. Please note that you cannot opt for both English Literature and English Language.
English Literature	6 in English Language and 5 in English Literature. Please note that you cannot opt for both English Literature and English Language.
French	6 in French
Further Mathematics	9 in Maths, or high 8 with teacher recommendation
Geography	6 in Geography (if taken at GCSE) or Grade 6 in English Language or English Literature (if not).
German	6 in German
History	6 in History (if taken at GCSE) or Grade 6 in English Language or English Literature (if not).
Law	6 in English Language or English Literature
Mathematics	6 in Maths
Media Studies	6 in Media Studies (if taken at GCSE) or Grade 6 in English Language or English Literature.

A level Subject	GCSE Entry requirements
<i>Photography</i>	<i>Minimum of 5 x grade 4 at GCSE (GCSE Art not essential)</i>
<i>Physical Education</i>	<i>6 in PE, plus 6 in Triple Science Biology or 6-5 in Combined Science</i>
<i>Physics</i>	<i>6 in Triple Science Physics or 6-6 in Combined Science and 5 in Maths.</i>
<i>Politics</i>	<i>Grade 6 in either History, English Language or English Literature.</i>
<i>Psychology</i>	<i>Grade 6 in English Language or English Literature and a 5 in Maths.</i>
<i>Sociology</i>	<i>6 in Sociology (if taken at GCSE) or Grade 6 in English Language or English Literature (if not).</i>
<i>Spanish</i>	<i>6 in Spanish</i>
Other Level 3 Subjects	GCSE Entry requirements
<i>Applied Business</i>	<i>Business is not essential, but if taken, then minimum grade 4/level 2 pass is expected. Please note that you cannot opt for either Economics or Business A-Level with Business Applied</i>
<i>Applied Science</i>	<i>A minimum of grade 5 in Maths GCSE and 5-5 in Combined Science GCSE. Please note these two courses are paired together and so it is not possible to only study one of them.</i>
<i>Core Maths</i>	
<i>Food Science & Nutrition</i>	<i>GCSE Food Preparation & Nutrition is not essential but, if taken, then a grade 4 is expected</i>
<i>Health & Social Care</i>	
<i>IT</i>	<i>Minimum grade 4/ Level 2 Pass in ICT if taken or grade 4 in Computer Science if taken. Please note that you cannot opt for both Information Technology and Computer Science.</i>
<i>Music</i>	<i>Grade 5 in any instrument or the ability to perform at the equivalent of grade 5 in any instrument</i>
<i>Travel & Tourism</i>	<i>Travel and Tourism is not essential but, if taken, then a Level 2 Pass is required</i>
<i>3D Design</i>	<i>A proven aptitude for creative thinking, designing and making. A GCSE in Art or a Technology subject is helpful but not essential.</i>

Level 2 Package

Psychology GCSE, Citizenship GCSE, Health & Social Care Cambridge National Certificate with English Language GCSE and/or Maths GCSE as required. Work experience one day a week.

2x GCSE grade 4/Level 2 pass and 2 x GCSE grade 3
