Health and Social Care is a great course to study if you want to work with people. Both courses take two years. Lessons are varied as you will study a combination of coursework and examined units. Lesson activities include discussion, research, practical activities, completing coursework, group work and much more.

What skills will I gain from studying Health and Social Care?

Health and Social Care helps you to develop the skills and knowledge required to work in Health and Social Care careers. Completing the coursework units will help you to develop skills in research, writing, organisation and referencing. You will also be assessed on some practical skills including your communication.

Having studied Health and Social Care what opportunities will be open to me?

This course prepares students for Health Care courses such as nursing and counselling, Social Care courses such as social work and youth work and Childcare courses such as teaching.
