## Year 12 Mock Examinations

The Year 12 mock examinations will take place after half term from **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June to Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> June**, as shown on the attached timetable. The whole Year 12 timetable will be suspended for these 10 days and all students will have study leave. Students who do not have many exams must spend their time productively consolidating their learning and reading around their subjects. Students who study one or more courses where a mock exam is not being taken, will be expected to attend school or complete work remotely, as directed by the relevant Head of Department, to continue with their coursework in non-mock exam subjects. Clearly, the coming weeks are of considerable importance for students and it is crucial that they undertake a structured **revision programme**. The skills developed now by students will be of great benefit next year for the external exams.

These mock exams will provide an important measure of the progress made and are scheduled at this stage in order to allow students time to respond to their outcome. The following week, staff will be marking the tests and entering the data for the fourth **Year 12 Progress Report**. This report, which will be issued on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> July, will focus on Current Performance Indicators (CPI's), target grades, exam scores, attitude to learning and deadlines. The results from these exams will be used, in conjunction with other data, to help generate UCAS predicted grades for next year.

Progress into Year 13 requires students to have met the minimum academic standard of a July CPI of an E/pass. We will be holding Progression Interviews for identified Year 12 students on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July. The students who will be required to attend a Progression Interview will be those who have achieved at least one E/U CPI grade (for A level subjects) or at least one Pass/Fail CPI grade (for applied subjects) in the July progress report. The mock exams, along with all other assessment data from this year will be used to generate the CPI for the July report.

We hope that this letter keeps you informed about the pattern of assessment in Year 12 and alerts you to the importance of the next few weeks in particular. If you wish to discuss any aspect of this process, do not hesitate to get in touch with us.
