Year 7 Fieldtrip to Cuckmere Haven, South Downs National Park

The Geography Department is delighted to offer Year 7 students the opportunity to visit Cuckmere Valley, in the South Downs National Park. The outdoors is a valuable resource for geographical learning. On the day, students will walk over the South Downs and complete a variety of fieldwork activities. Students will gain first-hand, practical experience of concepts explored in the classroom such as map skills, river processes and coastal processes, as well as the impacts of tourism in National Parks.

There are 50 spaces available for each day of the trip, which will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Places will be secured by booking on WisePay. The dates of the trip are Tuesday 3rd June (Block 1) and Thursday 5th June (Block 2). Students will only attend **one** of these days, depending on which block they are in:

BLOCK 1- Tuesday 3rd June

Block 1 forms: 7ACT, 7JNO, 7POB, 7RPA, 7SSM, 7TLA

BLOCK 2- Thursday 5th June

Block 2 forms: 7BLU, 7GBE, 7GGR, 7MVN, 7TEL

The trip will cost £13.00, which includes all transport costs, insurance and the resources required for the trip. Students will be leaving school at 8.30am and are expected to return to school at 3:00pm. Students will need to come to school at the normal time and meet on the coach, parked outside the main reception, at 8:25 am. Arrangements will need to be made to pick up your child from school at the return time.

Students will NOT be required to wear school uniform on this trip. Students need to be sensibly dressed for the weather, wearing comfortable trainers or walking boots. All students will need to bring a packed lunch and writing equipment. They may also wish to bring some spending money.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £13.00 which will cover the cost of the visit including transport and other incidental costs. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents/carers, who are able to, are willing to contribute.

Payment can be made through the Hazelwick School Internet Payments system, WisePay, via the school website [Hazelwick School - Hazelwick School - Home Page \(wisepay.co.uk\)](https://www.hazelwick.org/teaching-and-learning/insight-parent-portal).

Please note, before payment in WisePay can be made, tick box must be acknowledged which confirms your consent and that the school has the correct medical and contact information for your child.

Medical and contact details must be checked/amended and verified via Insight, which is on the school website <https://www.hazelwick.org/teaching-and-learning/insight-parent-portal>. Please note, all parents/carers have separate access to their own Insight accounts and can only see, and

verify or request changes to, their own contact details. If you have any issues with Insight, please email insight@hazelwick.org.uk for assistance.

For all students where their medical information indicates they use an inhaler or autoinjector, they will need to bring this with them on the day of this trip. Failure to bring their inhaler or autoinjector may mean they will be prevented from attending this offsite activity.
