Dear Parent/Carer

The last day of this term is Friday 19th December and the school day will finish at 1.25pm, at the end of lesson 4, when students will be dismissed to return home.

On Friday 19th December, students in Years 7, 8, 9, 10, 12 and 13 will be able to sparkle with Christmas cheer and wear a Christmas jumper as part of their uniform. This is a great opportunity for students and staff alike to show their festive side at the end of term. We also see this as an excellent opportunity to raise some money for a worthy local charity before the term ends for the holiday. This year the Christmas jumper day will raise money for the Greenaway Foundation. At this time of year, they offer support to local families that are struggling, offering a festive meal and providing presents and wishes to children who would otherwise go without. Their support also extends to other times of the year, for example with help for prom outfits. This is all funded through donations. There will be a chance for students to make an optional donation that will go straight to this very worthy local cause. The suggested donation amount is £1 although any donations are voluntary and will be gratefully received.

The Christmas jumpers can replace the Hazelwick blazer for the day and will be worn over their shirt and tie. Students will not be allowed to wear a non-Christmas jumper to replace their blazer for the day.

Additionally, staff are putting on the Christmas Karaoke Show for Years 7, 8 and 9 on Weds 17th December and for Years 10, 12 & 13 Thurs 18th December. Tickets will cost £2 and will be on sale for Years 7-9 at the Y7 end of the South playground at break and lunch time on Weds 10th December. For Years 10, 12 and 13, tickets will be on sale in the Quad in Upper School at break and lunch time on December 11th. Tickets are limited for this exciting showcase of staff talent!

On the day, lunch will be longer than normal to allow students to watch the show. Students attending karaoke will need to either bring a packed lunch or purchase food at morning break as there will not be time to purchase lunch as well as attending karaoke on the day.

As this festive period approaches, please can we remind all parents/carers that Hazelwick is a nut free school. There are members of our school community that have incredibly serious airborne allergies to nuts. Please can we therefore ask all students and parents/carers to be
