Dear Parent/Carer

Year 10 History trip to London

This letter is to confirm that your child has been allocated, subject to payment, a place on the Year 10 history trip to London.

The trips will take place on Wednesday 6th May (students from 10B/Hi4, 10D/Hi7, 10A and Thursday 7th May (all other classes). We shall be leaving at 9am and returning by 3pm. Students should arrive at school for the usual time (8:25am) and go to registration. After being registered, they will need to go to the dining hall to meet before walking to Three Bridges station. At the end of the day, they will be dismissed from Three Bridges station.

There will not be an opportunity to buy food during the day so students will **need to bring a packed lunch and a drink with them.** There will be an opportunity to buy souvenirs in the gift shop so students may bring a small amount of money. Students will be responsible for looking after their own money. **Students need to wear full school uniform on the trip.** Students may wear trainers if they wish.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £23.50, which will cover the cost of the visit including transport and other incidental costs. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents/carers, who are able to, are willing to contribute. If you are unable to contribute, you are invited to contact me in confidence, to discuss whether it is possible to reach some mutual arrangement. Payment can be made through the Hazelwick School Internet Payments system, [WisePay](#), via the school website.

In Wisepay, please can you tick the check box to verify that the medical details we have on Insight are correct or tick the box that states you have updated medical information.

Medical and contact details must be checked/amended and verified via Insight before making payment. For all students where their medical information indicates they use an inhaler or autoinjector, they will need to bring this with them on the day of this trip. Failure to bring their inhaler or autoinjector may mean they will be prevented from attending this offsite activity.

If your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium grant, then we can use this funding to cover the cost of this trip. If you have any queries with Insight, please email insight@hazelwick.org.uk for assistance.

As this trip is so popular, if we do not receive payment by **Friday 6th February**, then your child's place may be offered to another student.
