Year 7 Earthshot Fair 2026

We are excited to announce the launch of the Earthshot Fair which will be taking place at the end of the summer term.

The Earthshot prize was launched in 2020 by Prince William and David Attenborough. He created 5 themes and each theme has their own goals to help repair the planet by 2030.

The purpose of this fair is to encourage knowledge about our planet, increasing engagement of students and increase community spirit. Each form group will be making 1 game each (11 games across the cohort) based on their theme.

Over half term, your child may want to start researching more about their theme allocated or brainstorm any ideas of games that they can create on return. We want these games to be eco-friendly!

Closer to July their form will become closer to realising their intentions, and you will get more clarity on what their form decided and materials they need to bring in (if any).

After half term, students will be spending 2-3 geography lessons learning about their theme to help them. Head of Year will be allocating 1-2 form times a week where students will have the opportunity to work on their games with their form tutor.

Students have also been given the opportunity to design a stamp for our fair. Any stamps created can be given to Ms Frampton or to the geography office by room 39.
