Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our Careers Education, Information, and Guidance programme, all Year 10 students will take part in an upcoming Army Careers Activity event.

This will take place on Wednesday 3rd June and Thursday 4th June 2026, with approximately half of the year group attending on each day. Your child will be allocated to one of these days.

- The event will begin with an introductory presentation covering Army roles, lifestyle, and career opportunities.
- Following the presentation, students will take part in a programme of practical, team-based activities running throughout the day. These activities are designed to give students a hands-on experience while developing key transferable skills such as teamwork, resilience, leadership, and communication.
- Students will attend their normal lessons around their scheduled activities, so the school day will continue as usual.

This experience supports several of the Gatsby Benchmarks, particularly those relating to encounters with employers and employees, experiences of work, and raising awareness of a broad range of career pathways beyond GCSEs.

Students must:

- Wear their school PE kit and trainers for the full day (they do not need to change back into uniform).
- Bring a water bottle to stay hydrated throughout the activities.
- Be prepared for the weather (e.g. suncream/hat if necessary).

We hope that students will find this event both engaging and valuable as they begin to consider their future career pathways.
