Dear Parent/Carer,

The weather is forecast to get warmer for the rest of this week and beyond and Hazelwick's Summer Uniform will therefore be applied from Thursday 18th June. This will apply until further notice. Any changes back to normal school uniform will be communicated by email if required.

Under the Summer Uniform, students do not need to bring their blazers to school. They are allowed to undo their top buttons and slightly loosen their tie. Shirts should remain tucked in and students should continue to look smart at all times. If a student wishes to wear anything over their school shirt, this must be a blazer and they cannot replace a blazer with an additional item such as a hoody, jumper or coat. Students will also need to continue to ensure that they do not wear bracelets, rings or any jewellery other than a pair of stud earring in the lower lobe of the ear. Persistent uniform infringements will lead to items being confiscated. Students can of course continue to wear full school uniform if they wish.

It is important that students maintain their high levels of effort and application in lessons. They should therefore ensure that any equipment or timetables that they usually keep in their blazer are transferred over to their school bag.
