Dear Parent/Carer,

As you know, Hazelwick Summer Uniform is already in force. However, in light of the particularly high temperatures forecast next week, as an additional adjustment, Hazelwick students in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 will be allowed to wear their Hazelwick PE kit next week if they wish. This is not compulsory and students may continue to wear Hazelwick Summer Uniform without a tie if they would prefer. Those choosing to wear PE kit must wear Hazelwick PE kit (as detailed on the school website in the Parents/Carers section) with PE trainers; alternative non-Hazelwick items cannot be worn instead. This includes NikePro cycling shorts and others cycling shorts in a similar style. Students choosing to wear Hazelwick Summer Uniform must wear this with school shoes. It is unlikely that students will need a second layer next week, however, if they would like a second layer, they should wear an item of Hazelwick PE kit (if choosing to wear Hazelwick PE kit) or their school blazer (if choosing to wear Hazelwick Summer Uniform). Mr O'Brien, Head of PE, has sent an email about appropriate PE kit earlier today.

Students will not be allowed to go about their school day if they are not wearing correct uniform or PE kit. Parents/carers will be contacted to bring in correct clothing. We would of course like to avoid this so your support in ensuring they are dressed as per the details above is much appreciated.

Students are not permitted to wear flip flops, sliders, Crocs or sandals. If students wear such items of footwear, parents/carers will be contacted to ask them to bring in appropriate shoes, and sanctions will be issued to students.

We are also aware that some students may only have one PE top. If they are unable to wash and dry their top at the end of the school day, they may therefore need to wear summer uniform instead for one day next week to allow a top to be washed.

In this warm weather, please can I take the opportunity to remind you of the importance of students having a refillable water bottle with them. Sun cream should also be applied if they are likely to spend prolonged periods of time outside. We will be implementing other measures to support students, including staff reminding students to refill water bottles regularly, and sporting activities at lunchtime stopping 5 minutes earlier to allow students time to get a drink and try and cool down before lessons resume.

We have our Sports Days scheduled for Wednesday and Thursday next week. This normally entails students participating in their year groups, with each year group's event last 2.5 hours. We will continue to review the weather forecast early next week in relation to Sports Days. A further uniform update will be sent on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June.
