I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents/carers, who are able to, are willing to contribute. Students will need to provide their own food and refreshments. Students who receive free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch. We will be departing school from the Art and Photography Department at 08:35 and will return at 3pm.

Payment can be made through the Hazelwick School Internet Payments system, [WisePay](#), via the school website. In Wisepay, please can you tick the check box to verify that the medical details we have on Insight are correct.

Medical and contact details must be checked/amended and verified via [Insight](#) before making payment. For all students where their medical information indicates they use an inhaler or autoinjector, they will need to bring this with them on the day of this trip. Failure to bring their inhaler or autoinjector may mean they will be prevented from attending this offsite activity.
