Dear Parent/Carer,

In order to support students studying GCSE Music, it is necessary for us to give students some intervention to prepare for their performance exams.

Many students will have been without an instrument or instrumental lessons throughout the lockdown period and this means that we need to get support in place early so that students have time to practise and prepare for the exams which will take place in January and February.

In the coming weeks, we will make sure that your child knows exactly what they will be performing for their exam. As a part of their ongoing work at home, they need to be practising their chosen piece of music on their instrument for up to 1 hour per week over three 20 minute slots where possible.

In addition to their practice at home, we will be booking in an afterschool workshop with your child to help them prepare. Please be advised that this will take place between 3pm and 4pm in the Music Department.
