Dear Parent/Carer

Mock Examinations: Tuesday 1st December – Friday 18th December 2020

I wrote to you earlier this month regarding arrangements for the forthcoming year 11 mock examinations and the changes to the timetable that would be occurring during this period. With the situation in school ever changing and our first COVID-19 cases being confirmed in the last week, we have reviewed our plan and feel that it would be in the students' best interests for further modifications to the timetable to be made.

From Tuesday 1st December, the Year 11 lesson timetable will be collapsed completely and Year 11 students will only be expected to attend for their examinations. You will have received a separate email with your son's/daughter's statement of entry, which details the subject, date, time, location and seat number for each exam. Once their exam has been completed they will leave the site and return home. When not in an exam, students should be at home to study independently, making use of this time and consolidating the learning that has taken place here in school.

Whilst we feel this is the most beneficial way for the students to work during this period, we understand that this may not be feasible for those students who will find it difficult to travel home after a morning exam and then return to school for an exam, later that morning or in the afternoon. In this case, we are able to offer a number of spaces in school for supervised study; the student would need to bring revision materials with them to work on.
