Dear Parent/Carer,

To enable teachers to accurately assess students this term we have an online assessment week, from Monday 22nd to Friday 26th February, the first week back after half term. During this week students will have an hour long assessment for each of their subjects. To enable the assessments to be fair for all students, we will be using the attached timetable to ensure all students complete the assessment at the same time.

Students will be given the assessed task at the start of the lesson and will be expected to complete the task and submit it back to their teacher one hour later. Each assessment will be bespoke for individual subjects and will enable students to show their teachers the level of understanding they have on a specific area of the syllabus. Heads of Department will issue students with guidance on the content and style of the assessment so that they can fully prepare.

It is vital that students access the assessment on time at the start of the lesson and submit it back to their teacher before the end of the lesson. Work that is late will not be graded. If a student will be unable to access the assessment at that time due to technology issues, please contact Mrs Hughes in advance, using the email below, and we will arrange for that assessment to be safely conducted in school.

To ensure that students are as fully prepared as possible they must attend all available online lessons. It is pleasing to see the majority of Year 12 continuing to produce work of the highest quality and seek support from their teachers. A small minority of students are not attending lessons in the morning as they are over sleeping or they have chosen not to engage; this will have a detrimental impact on their progress and CPI's and could affect their progression into Year 13. If students are unable to access lessons online at home then we may be able to offer students a place in school to work each day. If this is an issue, please contact Mrs Hughes on the email below.
