

Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 7 Examinations will begin on Monday 14th February and will finish on Friday 18th February 2022. A copy of the exam timetable is attached.

Please be aware that students will complete exams in Maths, English, Science, Geography and History. These exams will be completed in North or South Hall and not in normal timetabled classrooms. However, students will be completing Modern Foreign Language exams in their normal lessons. The specific date of these exams will be decided by their Modern Foreign Language teachers and this will be communicated to the students in lessons and on Satchel:One.

A Hazelwick Revision Booklet will be issued to Year 7 students to help them with their revision. It will contain a range of subject specific information, as well as revision tips such as these:

- Keep your Hazelwick Revision Booklet in your school bag so you can revise during form time.
- Create an exam and revision timetable that tells you a) When the exams are b) When you are going to revise c) Which topics to revise
- If you are struggling with a topic, try making: Mind maps or Flashcards or Songs or Mnemonics or Drawings
- Find a quiet place to revise and switch off your phone
- Revise in 15, 20 or 30 minute sessions and take short rests between them
- Make sure you get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast on the day of your exam to ensure you are ready to do your best
- Make sure you always have a spare pen, bottle of water and revision materials with you on the day of the exam

My Myers will also conduct a Year 7 Examinations Assembly, where he will explain the processes and expectations of the exam period.

Behaviour Rules during Exams at Hazelwick School

- > For exams in the Hall, wait in silence in the canteen next to your Hall and wait to be called in
- From the moment you step inside the exam hall or classroom where you will be tested, <u>you must be</u> <u>silent</u>
- > Sit at your place and put your equipment on the desk. Face the front at all times
- > Do not talk or look at anyone else
- If the exam paper is already on your desk, do not open it or write on it until the teacher says you may do so
- When the teacher gives instructions listen carefully. If you do not understand, put your hand up and wait patiently for the teacher to come to you. Do not ask another student to help you
- > If you need help during the exam, put up your hand
- > At the end of the exam remember that you must stay silent until the teacher says that it is OK to talk.

These rules for exams are the same all the way through Hazelwick, by learning them now you will be well prepared for all future exam times.
