Year 12D level Geography Fieldwork to Brighton on 10th May 2022

As part of their AQA A level course students will be studying changing places and contemporary environments. This day trip will visit their local case study – Brighton.

The cost of the day trip is £8 which includes all transport costs, insurance and the resources required for the trip. Students will be meeting at Three Bridges train station for the 09.41 am train to Brighton. At Brighton station Miss-Schoonraad will meet them. Students will take the 2.25pm train from Brighton and arrive in Three Bridges at 2.57 pm. Arrangements will need to be made to pick up your son/daughter from Three Bridges train station. Please note that students will not be accompanied by a teacher during the train journeys.

Students will NOT be required to wear school uniform on this trip. Students need to be sensibly dressed. They may also wish to bring some spending money.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £8 which will cover the cost of the train. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents/carers, who are able to, are willing to contribute.

Please note, before payment in WisePay can be made, two tick boxes must be acknowledged to confirm your consent and that the school has the correct medical and contact information for your son/daughter.

Please note, all parents/carers have separate access to their own Insight accounts and can only see, and verify or request changes to, their own contact details.
