Students will take the 2.25pm train from Brighton and arrive in Three Bridges at 2.57pm. Arrangements will need to be made to pick up your son/daughter from Three Bridges train station. Please note that students will not be accompanied by a teacher during the train journeys.

Students should bring a notebook and money (they will have the opportunity to buy lunch if they wish).

Students will NOT be required to wear school uniform on this trip. Students need to be sensibly dressed.
