

Dear Parent/Carer

I would like to remind you about the Sixth Form Introductory Meeting which will be held on Thursday 6th October. This meeting is both for parents/carers of Year 11 students and for students themselves who are considering entry to the Sixth Form next September.

The Sixth Form Prospectus (which will also be available on the school website just prior to the Open Evening) includes general detail about Hazelwick's Sixth Form provision and information outlining the nature of all the courses on offer in September 2023.

There are two main elements to the evening:

5.30 - 6.00 pm, in **South Hall** (Lower School), there will be a presentation about the sixth form by the Headteacher, Head of Sixth Form and the Student Leadership Team. This same presentation will be repeated from 6.15 - 6.45 pm.

5.30 - 7.30 pm, in **East Building** (Upper School), departments will be putting on displays and explaining the nature and range of the sixth form level 3 and level 2 courses they offer; it will be possible to talk informally to staff and sixth formers about the nature of their work.

In addition, senior staff will be available for informal, general discussions throughout the evening.

There are many questions that you may wish to have answered at this meeting, both about the changing nature of the post-16 curriculum and about the advantages and possibilities of sixth form education at Hazelwick. I look forward to seeing you at this meeting.
