## The Spike Heritage Centre Visit - 12<sup>th</sup> December 2022

I have arranged a trip for Year 13 students to visit a workhouse museum in Guildford to enhance their learning of the Poor Law in Victorian Britain. The trip will take place on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December visiting The Spike Heritage Centre in Guildford. Students depart from school after registration and will travel to Guildford via coach. Students will take part in a variety of activities investigating the routine of the workhouse and the reasons for people entering, experience using primary evidence as Poor Law historians and undertake a tour of the site. Students will leave Guildford at 2pm and return to school by approximately 3pm.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £19.50 which will cover the cost of the visit including transport and other incidental costs. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents/carers, who are able to, are willing to contribute.
