Rationale

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer (Baker Clause). This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student entitlement

All students in years 8-13 are entitled:

- To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

At Hazelwick School we encourage all students, including students in Year 7, to participate in our Careers Education programme so we would also include those students in any activities which a provider would like to offer therefore providing access to all students in all year groups.

The Careers Leader (with strategic responsibility for Careers) will monitor, evaluate and review this policy through analysis of practice and dialogue with stakeholders and will present any amendments to SLT for approval on an annual basis in conjunction with the Hazelwick School Careers Education Policy annual review.
