Year 11 GCSE Geography Fieldwork skills to Grattons Park, Crawley

As part of the GCSE Geography course, all students are required to complete two days of fieldwork outside the school grounds. Students are asked questions on planning and completing a fieldwork enquiry as well as questions on their own fieldwork enquiry (one for human and one for physical Geography).

Our fieldwork enquiry will investigate how successful the restoration of Grattons Park, Crawley has been. This is a case study for their hydrology module. During the morning trip, your son/daughter will be required to undertake several data collection methods to investigate the success of Grattons Park.

All Year 11 GCSE Geography students are required to attend this one-morning trip. Students will meet on the lower school playground at 8.30 am. We are expected to return to school at 11 am in time for break and lesson 3. The dates of the trip are Monday 2nd, Wednesday 4th and Friday 6th October. Your son/daughter will only attend one of these mornings, depending on the class they are in:

Monday 2nd October – 11D/Gg5 and 11D/Gg6

Wednesday 4th October - 11A/Gg1 and 11C/Gg4

Friday 6th October – 11B/Gg2 and 11B/Gg3

There is no cost to this Geography fieldtrip.

Students are required to bring wellington boots or waterproof shoes with them that day.
