## Year 7 One-Day Trip to Boulogne-Sur-Mer

I am writing to tell you about a one-day trip to Boulogne-Sur-Mer available to students of French currently in Year 7. We will leave early on the morning of **Friday 7**<sup>th</sup> **June (Block 1) or Friday 14**<sup>th</sup> **June (Block 2)** and return to Hazelwick School at around 9.30pm on Friday evening. The cost of this trip will be in the region of £125 per student. The final cost will be determined once final numbers of students are known. The cost includes:

- Return coach and ferry travel from Hazelwick
- Comprehensive Insurance
- All other visits and activities

The cost of meals is not included in the price, and students will need to bring a packed lunch and a small amount of spending money in euros to purchase any other meals or snacks. To travel to France, your child will need their own passport, valid for at least six months from the date of departure.

Students will also need a <u>Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC)</u>, which is available **free of charge** at <u>www.nhs.uk</u>. Alternatively a valid EHIC card will still be accepted.

If you wish your child to take part, you are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £62 on the school payments system, WisePay by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February. Please also complete the attached form. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents/carers, who are able to, are willing to contribute.

The <u>Wisepay</u> online payment system will be open from 8.15am on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> January. Places on the visit are limited to 45 on each day. Should your child get a place on the trip, then I must point out that the first payment is non-returnable. Should your child not get a place, their name will be put on a reserve list in case anyone drops out. Please be aware that making an initial payment does not guarantee a place on the trip. If numbers are insufficient to run both day trips, then we will run a single trip on 14<sup>th</sup> June. Places will be allocated to those who paid first. The second payment of £63 will be due on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

As this trip is not required as an essential part of the KS3 French course therefore there is only a limited amount of financial help available for those who are eligible.
