Dear Parent/Carer,

As the A levels draw near, staff and students are speaking about the importance of making the most of the Easter break in terms of maintaining regular revision. This is a large period of time away from lessons and in the important run up to the summer exams, work undertaken now can make a crucial difference to a final grade.

We are aware that some students would welcome and benefit from the opportunity to study in a quiet space in school during the Easter break and we would like to offer this to them, using the sixth form areas as a place for private study.

School will be available for independent study sessions from Tuesday 2nd April – Friday 5th April and then the following week from Tuesday 9th April – Friday 12th April. The morning sessions will run from 9.00 – 12.30 and the afternoon sessions will run from 1.00 – 3.30. There will be a short break during both the morning and afternoon sessions. There will be no canteen facilities so students should bring any refreshments or snacks that they may want to have during their break. Students will not be required to wear school uniform.

The independent study sessions will be supervised by staff, though students will need to bring their own work with them, and they will need to remain in the sixth form area and will not have access to other areas of school. This is an opportunity for them to have a quiet space in which to undertake revision on their own, making use of the sixth form study area.
