Year 11 GCSE Geography Fieldwork skills to Grattons Park, Crawley

As part of the GCSE Geography course, all students are required to complete two days of fieldwork outside the school grounds. Students are asked questions on planning and completing a fieldwork enquiry as well as questions on their own fieldwork enquiry (one for human and one for physical Geography).

Our fieldwork enquiry will investigate how successful the restoration of Grattons Park, Crawley has been. This is a case study for their hydrology module. During the morning trip, your child will be required to undertake several data collection methods to investigate the success of Grattons Park.

All Year 11 GCSE Geography students are required to attend this one-morning trip. Students will meet on the lower school playground at 8.45 am. We are expected to return to school at 11 am in time for break and lesson 3. The dates of the trip are Monday 16th, Tuesday 17th and Friday 20th September. Your child will only attend one of these mornings, depending on the class they are in:

Monday 16th September -11A/Gg1 and 11D/Gg6

Tuesday 17th September –11A/Gg2 and 11C/Gg5

Friday 20th September –11B/Gg3 and 11B/Gg4

There is no cost to this Geography fieldtrip.

Students are required to bring wellington boots or waterproof shoes with them that day.

For all students where their medical information indicates they use an inhaler or autoinjector, they will need to bring this with them on the day of this trip. Failure to bring their inhaler or autoinjector may mean they will be prevented from attending this offsite activity.

Medical and contact details must be checked/amended and verified via Insight.
