## **Law Trip to the Old Bailey and Supreme Court. Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2024.**

Year 13 Law students have the opportunity to visit the Supreme Court (**Parliament Square, London, SW1P 3BD**) and the Old Bailey (Old Bailey, London, EC4M 7EH) **on 3<sup>rd</sup> October**. The Supreme Court is the most important appeal court in our country; the Old Bailey is the most significant Crown Court.

Students need to meet me at Three Bridges Station main entrance at 0830 on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October. We will travel to London Bridge by train and then use the underground to get to our venues. Students should bring a packed lunch with them. If they have photo identification, it would be helpful if they bring that too.

They should keep what they bring with them to a minimum. Security at both venues is extremely tight. When we go into a trial at the Old Bailey in the afternoon, students will not be able to take mobile phones or smart watches into the court and we will need to leave all our belongings with the Police. Please be aware that almost all trials at the Old Bailey feature very serious criminal offences.

We should return to Three Bridges Station no later than 5.30pm where students will make their own way home. I will ask students to contact you when we are on the train home to give you a more precise arrival time.

Should you consent to your child attending, you are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £25 which will cover the cost of the visit, including travelling by train, underground and other incidental costs. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents/carers, who are able to, are willing to contribute.

For all students where their medical information indicates they use an inhaler or autoinjector, they will need to bring this with them on the day of this trip. Failure to bring their inhaler or autoinjector may mean they will be prevented from attending this offsite activity.
