Dear Parent/Carer

The Spike Heritage Centre Visit – Thursday 12th December 2024

I have arranged a trip for Year 13 students to visit a workhouse museum in Guildford to enhance their learning of the Poor Law in Victorian Britain. The trip will take place on Thursday 12th December visiting The Spike Heritage Centre in Guildford. Students depart from school after registration and will travel to Guildford via either the school minibus or the private vehicle of a member of staff. Students will take part in a variety of activities investigating the routine of the workhouse and the reasons for people entering, experience using primary evidence as Poor Law historians and undertake a tour of the site. Students will leave Guildford at 2pm and return to school by approximately 3pm.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £11.00 which will cover the cost of the visit including transport and other incidental costs. I must, however, tell you that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents/carers, who are able to, are willing to contribute. If you require assistance in paying, please do not hesitate to contact myself.
